Qualifications:

- Appreciation of the outdoors and desire to share it with others.
- First Aid and CPR certification (Rutabaga will provide training opportunities).
- Must be able to move boats; load and unload trailers; and spend multiple hours outside.
- Must be able to attend training June 7-10th
- Experience working with youth is preferred.
- The ability to drive vans and trailers is preferred. Training will be provided.
- Paddling experience is preferred, but not required training will be provided.

Work Hours:

Work hours are generally between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm on weekdays, June-August. Some evening, weekend, spring, and fall work is available.
